

QSC 21 Health & Safety Guidelines:

Qualys is committed to providing a safe and healthy experience for all QSC participants.

Below you will find essential information to enhance the safety and comfort of all participants.

As COVID-19 and pertinent health & safety guidelines evolve, these guidelines will continue to be adapted and updated to have the safest event possible.

QSC21 Expectations for all event participants:

- Individuals who are immunocompromised or at high risk are encouraged to attend virtually.
- All event participants are expected to observe and engage in recognized preventive actions to help ensure a safe environment, including frequent hand washing.
- Individuals should not attend the event if they have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days or if they are concerned that they have been exposed to the virus within 14 days and could possibly test positive.
- Should an event participant test positive for COVID-19, register a temperature, or become ill during the event, he/she/they should observe quarantining procedures

All those planning to attend in-person will be asked to adhere to the following health & safety guidelines:

- **Daily Temperature Checks**
 - Everyone attending QSC21 in Las Vegas will be required to undergo a temperature check prior to entry.
 - Qualys will employ various mechanisms to temperature-screen attendees, including passive scanning of all attendees prior to entry to the venue each day.
 - Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 Fahrenheit will not be permitted to attend.

- **Increased sanitization and hand washing:**
 - QSC and the Bellagio hotel will implement increased hand sanitation and handwashing stations.
 - All participants will be expected to comply with CDC Guidelines regarding hand washing protocols.
- **Mask Mandate:**
 - As of July 30th, in accordance with the State of Nevada's Emergency Directive 045, all individuals regardless of vaccination status are required to wear a mask in public indoor settings.
 - Please note that regardless of state mask mandate at the time of the event, Qualys requires all participants to wear masks at all times except when actively eating, drinking, and where an exemption has been pre-approved.

 - Masks will be available to all attendees, but attendees are encouraged to bring their own masks.
 - If you are unable to wear a mask, the State of Nevada allows non-restrictive alternatives such as a face shield. You should supply your own face shield as QSC only has masks available.
 - Mask policy is subject to change, based on prevailing CDC, regional, and/or venue requirements at the time of the event.
- **Physical distancing:**
 - QSC has been planned to allow for physical distancing whenever possible. This includes a more open layout, space between seats in meeting rooms and an open registration layout.
- **Not feeling well?**
 - For the health and safety of all our participants, if you have any flu-like symptoms within the last 2 weeks prior to the event (fever and a cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose) or symptoms related to COVID-19 within the last 2 weeks prior to the event, we encourage you to stay home and join QSC virtually.

- **Getting to QSC in Las Vegas:**
 - The current travel restrictions implemented by the [U.S. Government](#) on April 31, 2021, remain in effect for this event.
 - Please refer to the latest restrictions and up-to-date guidelines when it becomes time to book your trip to QSC. Follow all current [CDC guidelines for travel](#), whether you're flying international or domestic.
 - Travelers are encouraged to get tested for COVID-19, 24 – 48 hours prior to flying to QSC21 in Las Vegas.
 - In addition please be aware, the CDC requires masks at public transportation hubs and on all public transportation. This includes but is not limited to airports, flights, taxi/ride share, local buses, and the Las Vegas Monorail.
