Include External Site to Weekly Scheduled Scan

You can now choose to include or exclude an external site from the weekly scheduled scan.

Simply navigate to Assets > External Sites and click Add Sites. Provide either FQDNs or IP Addresses of public sites that you want to scan for certificates.

Select the Add to Weekly Scan option to either include or exclude the site from the weekly scheduled scan.

Click Save to scan the sites at a later time or click Save and Start Scan to immediately scan the site.

Issues addressed in this release

- We fixed an issue where the list of internal scanner appliances was not visible while trying to launch the scan on the internal site via the Certview module.
- Fixed an issue where the QQL query in the dashboard widget was giving incorrect results for the following queries:
 - asset.instance.sslProtocols:"TLSv1"
 - certificate.instance.sslProtocols:"TLSv1"
- We fixed an issue where a scan of xcap.gateway.slb.com (51.124.150.246) in both SSL Labs and Certview was generating different results.
- Incorrect TLSv1 details were being displayed in the Dashboard widget. The issue is now fixed and accurate details are now displayed.
- Updated the Certificate View API user guide to change the JSON Web Token (JWT) expiration duration to 4 hours.
