Set Validity During Enrolling or Renewing Certificates

You can now set validity of the certificate for a year, for a specific date, or a particular duration, when you enroll or renew.

Simply, navigate to the Additional Options section of your Enroll or Renew certificate wizard and choose the validity you wish to set for your certificate.

Issues addressed in this release

- We fixed the issue where completed scans displayed the “Waiting for Results” status long after completing the scans. The scan status is accurately updated to show the correct scan status.
- With this release, we have fixed the grade discrepancies for a certificate that was observed between SSL Labs and Certificate View. For better clarity, we have updated the grade summary message to the following:
"This server supports weak Diffie-Hellman (DH) key exchange parameters. Grade capped to B."
