Option to Enable Agent Scan Merge for Configuration Profile

With this release, we have added an option to enable Agent Scan Merge for the configuration profile. If this option is enabled, unauthenticated and authenticated vulnerability scan results from agent VM scans for your cloud agent assets will be merged.

Prerequisites

Your agent hosts must have the minimum Cloud Agent version:

- Windows Agent version 4.2 or later
- Linux Agent version 3.1 or later

What are the steps?

Navigate to **Agent Management > Configuration Profiles** and then toggle **Enable Agent Scan Merge for this profile** to **ON** from **Agent Scan Merge** step of the **Configuration Profile Creation** if you wish to enable agent scan merge for the configuration profile.

Issues Addressed

We have fixed the following issues in this current release-



Vulnerability Management Detection and Response

- We have now fixed the issue so that the QID details page is now correctly displayed.



Cloud Agent

- Fixed an issue where Cloud Agent assets were not showing the EC2 Information tab on the Asset Details page even if there were EC2 instances.
- Fixed an issue where we were unable to download agent reports in XML and CSV format if the number of agents is large in number.



Administration

- The new Business Unit updates for users on Users tab now correctly reflect in Administration utility along with existing Business units associated with the user.
