Issues addressed in this release

Qualys Cloud Platform 2.40.1 brings you many more improvements and updates.

AV AssetView

- Fixed an issue where users with the Reader/Scanner role were unable to see assets in the Assets tab.
- Corrected the UI text on the Import Dashboard window.
- Fixed an issue where the "docker.hasSensor" token fetched inconsistent results.

CA Cloud Agent

- Fixed an issue where same search strings were fetching different results in AssetView and Cloud Agent. Now the results fetched in both cases are the same.
- Fixed an issue in Cloud Agent where the download option was not displayed for the BSD agent.

MD Malware Detection

- Users can now change the owner and/or Name of Schedules for MDS scheduled scan from any user to themselves.

SAQ Security Assessment Questionnaire

- We have fixed an issue and the Questionnaire Manager can now see the complete list of users and can also search user by name.

WAS Web Application Scanning

- The API response now returns accurate data for user using the search finding API with greater than operator filter or any other filter criteria.
- We have enhanced the label to "Web Application URL (or Swagger file URL)" for better clarity and understanding.

- We have fixed an issue so that the count of Azure instances is correctly displayed when static tags are being created using interface information.
