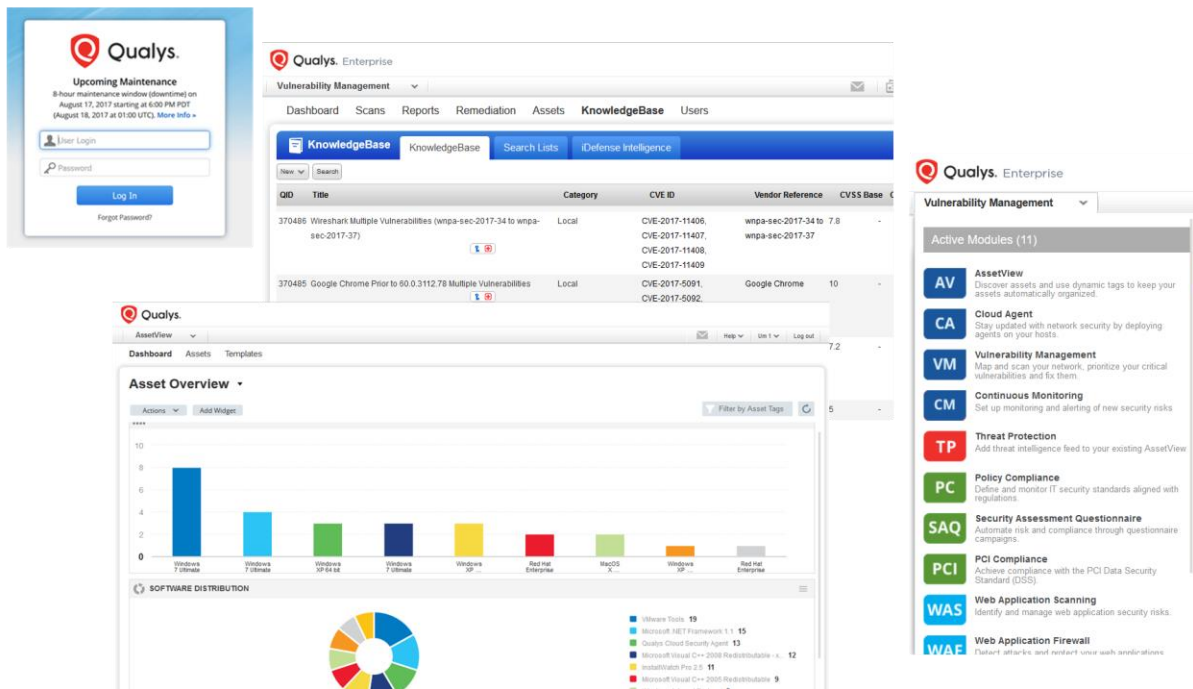
We're excited to tell you about this release of Qualys Cloud Suite including improvements to Qualys Vulnerability Management and Qualys Policy Compliance.

You'll see our new logo when you log into Qualys Cloud Platform. All apps now use our new logo, and our TP app is renamed to Threat Protection.



Qualys Cloud Suite 8.10.1.2 includes additional improvements as described below.

Issues addressed in this release

- Our new logo appears throughout the Qualys Cloud Platform UI.
- Threat Protection (TP) – Our TP app is now called Threat Protection throughout the Qualys Cloud Platform UI (previously it was ThreatPROTECT).
- We've updated Qualys online help and documentation with our new logo and branding changes.
- Fixed an issue where some users with the scanner role were unable to view the scanner appliance page (on Scans > Appliances tab). We provided the required permission to the scanner role so now scanner role users can see the appliances page with download option.
- The Host List API parameters “vm_processed_before” and “vm_processed_after” now filter results to return just the hosts processed and not all the related vulnerabilities.
- Fixed an issue where a customer received 999 error when making an API call.
- Fixed an issue where asset inventory data was not properly updated and user searches in AssetView returned incorrect results.
