# Mandated Test Connection for Connectors

Qualys cloud connectors allowed creating connectors for invalid auth records. As a result, we noticed many stale connectors with invalid auth records in the system.

We have now made test connection mandatory for creating or editing a connector of any cloud provider. Whenever the role information or the connector type is updated, you have to revalidate the connection.

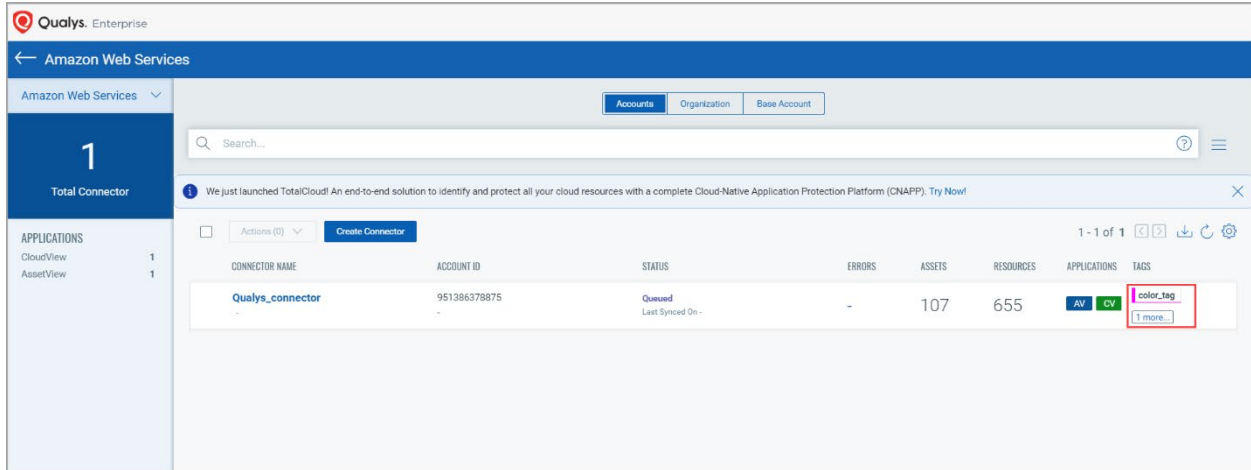

## Enhancements to Connector Listing Page

The Connector listing page in the Connector application is improved with additional fields and columns for easier reference. We have introduced two new columns- Tags and Assets.

- The Tags column displays Connector tags for all cloud providers.
- The Assets column displays the count of AWS EC2 Instances.



If there are multiple tags, they are listed in the column, and you can click on the tag names to view a popup that displays all the attached tags.
