Helm Chart Enhancements

An updated helm chart is now available. You can install the new helm chart from <https://artifacthub.io/packages/helm/qualys-helm-chart/qcs-sensor>.

Also, the helm chart scripts (`helm-chart-scripts.tar.xz`) are now deprecated and are not part of the sensor tar (`QualysContainerSensor.tar.xz`) anymore.

Upgrading Sensor to Version 1.21

- To upgrade the sensor deployed in Kubernetes (and used for a public registry) to version 1.21, you need to reinstall the sensor and specify the following proxy information under the **env** section of the `.yaml` file:

```
Uncomment and indent the proxy information properly, or keep it
as is if not required:
For a registry sensor version 1.21.0 or later used for a public
registry:
    #- name: https_proxy
    #  value: <proxy FQDN or Ip address>:<port#>
```

- For a standalone docker host with proxy configured in the docker daemon, you need to reinstall the sensor (used for a public registry) to upgrade it to version 1.21.
