What's New?

SCA: Support for New Programming Languages

SCA (Software Composition Analysis) scans can now detect software packages based on the following programming languages:

- PHP
- Ruby
- Rust

During an SCA scan, the sensor scans the following files for the packages based on PHP, Ruby, and Rust:

Language	Files
PHP	Composer.lock
Ruby	gemspec
Rust	Cargo.lock and Binaries built with cargo-auditable

Issues Addressed

The following issues have been fixed with this release:

- On the CRI-O runtime, in some cases, the status for deleted containers did not reflect correctly in the UI. This issue is now fixed.
- All sensors showed the same IP address after auto-upgrading to 1.16.0 or later. This issue is now fixed.

If the sensor with version earlier than 1.16.0 was auto-upgraded to a version between 1.16.0 to 1.21.0 (both versions included), you must reinstall the sensor with the latest version 1.22.0.

Reinstallation is not required if the sensor was auto-upgraded directly to 1.22.0.
