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## Group by CVE IDs on Vulnerability Tab

SEM 1.1.0-0 comes with new group by CVE IDs option on the Vulnerability listing page that allows user to get vulnerability view based on CVE IDs.

Additional improvement in Vulnerability detail page includes description in Detection Summary tab. The Vulnerability tab is now placed next to Inventory tab for easy accessibility.

## Export Assets Details in CSV

User can now export the asset details in CSV format.

The download icon to export/download the asset details.

Clicking the download icon will download all the listed assets for that subscription in a CSV file. E.g. if the user clicks on download when no search criteria is applied, then all listed assets are downloaded. And if the user enters search criteria, then only the listed assets are downloaded.

## Patch Management Enhancements

This release features the provision to Edit, Delete, Enable and Create disabled jobs for the users.

User can create a deployment job from the Job listing page and perform various functions on the created job such as, edit the added job, delete the completed job, enable the disabled job and also user can create a job with disable status.

## Changes on Vulnerability Tab

In SEM 1.1.0-0, the **Vulnerabilities** tab now a separate tab, earlier it was under Inventory tab. Also the **Job** tab is moved below vulnerability tab.
