Enable Factory Reset Permission

With this release, we introduced an “Enable Factory Reset” permission to restrict the **Factory Reset** action for specific users. The Admin User can grant this permission from the Administration module for the required user role and then assign that role to the required user.

Example - Enable Factory Reset permission granted to an existing user role.

Turn off Hotspot	Turns off Personal Hotspot.	Turn off Hotspot
Turn on Voice Roaming	Turns on Voice Roaming.	Turn on Voice Roaming
Turn off Voice Roaming	Turns off Voice Roaming.	Turn off Voice Roaming
Turn on Data Roaming	Turns on Data Roaming.	Turn on Data Roaming
Turn off Data Roaming	Turns off Data Roaming.	Turn off Data Roaming
De-enroll Asset	De-enroll the asset. Once an asset is de-enrolled all corporate data on the asset is deleted.	De-enroll Asset
Force De-enroll Asset	For an unreachable asset or if asset is in an unrecoverable stage, you may Force De-enroll the asset. This will mark it as 'de-enrolled'. The system will keep trying to reach the asset to complete de-enrollment.	Force De-enroll
Factory Reset	Admin can remotely perform a full wipe of the asset using this command. Wiping the asset removes all data.	Factory Reset

- We have fixed the issue where duplicate de-enrolled entries were shown for the same asset.
